In Pursuant to the Directorate of Food, Civil Supplies and Consumer Affairs, Assam, Guwahati's W.T. Message No. DS.4/2013/21 dated 11-7-2013 and in exercise of the powers conferred by clause-26 read with clause-28(b) of the Assam Public Distribution of Articles Order, 1982, I, Dr. J. Balaji, IAS, Deputy Commissioner, Kamrup, Amingaon do hereby make the Sub-allocation of Kerosene Oil (Blue dyed) for the month of **September/2013** in respect of existing appointed dealers (i.e. Sub-wholesellers) of Kamrup Sadar Sub-Division as detailed below for making ultimate distribution amongst the Family Identity Card holders through respective appointed retailers under GPSS/ WCCS etc. at the price already fixed by the Licensing Authority in this regard.

The sub-allocation of S.K Oil GPSS/WCCS wise etc. is made for the month of September, 2013 as follows :

- I. Each PDS nominee will get 5 Litres per FIC i.e. @ 4.000 Ltrs per FIC through FP Shop (Agent of the GPSS/ WCCS) and @ 1.000 Ltr through Hawkers/ Retailers of S.K Oil against FIC to be tagged by concerned Area officer, FCS & CA.
- II. However, in case of 226 No. of notified villages each PDS nominee will get 6 Litres per FIC and they shall take 6 Litres from FP Shop/Agent.
