In Pursuant to the Directorate of Food Civil Supplies and Consumer Affairs, Assam, Guwahati's W. T. Message No. DS. 71/2013/25 dated 13/02/2014 regarding monthly allocation of Rice for the AAY beneficiaries under TPDS scheme for the month of March /2014 and in exercise of the powers conferred by clause-26 read with clause-28(b) of the Assam Public Distribution of the Articles Order, 1982 and the provisions of the Public Distribution System (control) Order, 2001, I **Dr. J.Balaji IAS**, Deputy Commissioner and Licensing Authority, Kamrup, Amingaon do hereby make the allocation of **11413.15** quintals out of the Directorate's total allocation of **11413.30** quintals of such rice with the break up of **11135.95** quintals amongst 31817 numbers of AAY beneficiary families @ **35.00** kilograms per family per month for the GPSS/WCCS Limited Under Kamrup Sadar Sub-Division and **277.20** quintals for M/S Baghmara Char GPSS Limited under Barpeta District for the afore stated month respectively. The nominee GPSS/WCCS Limited are directed to deposit the Government fixed value of allotted Rice (AAY Category) to the F.C.I., Guwahati within **15/03/2014** for the month of **March /2014** quotas and arrange lifting of said rice there from within **20/03/2014**, without fail. They are also directed to submit the arrival report against lifting of AAY rice so allotted and issue the same to the appointed retailers (i. e Agents/FPS dealers) attached with them for ultimate distribution amongst Family Identity Card holders under P.D.S. at a quantum of **35.00** kgs per family per month each at the Govt. fixed rate.
