**ORDER**

In pursuance of the Director of Food Civil Supplies & Consumer Affairs Assam, Guwahati's order issued under Memo No. **DS-97/2013/71 Dated-31/07/2013** and **DS-127/2013/16 dtd. 08/08/2013** regarding allotment of whole-meal atta to be produced by the Roller Flour Mills out of APL wheat and Addl. APL wheat allotted for the months of **July,2013** and also on the basis of demand analysis assessment of requirement of w/atta per family in the Kamrup Sadar Sub-Division of Kamrup District as submitted by GPSS/WCCS, Inspectors FCS & CA Kamrup I, Dr. J. Balaji, IAS, Deputy Commissioner Kamrup Amingaon in exercise of the powers conferred by clause 26 read with clause 28(B) of the Assam Public Distribution of Articles Order, 1982 do hereby make the sub-allocation of aforementioned whole meal atta to the sub whole sellers of Kamrup Sadar Sub-Division for lifting from the respective R.F. Mills within 09/09/2013 on payment of price @ Rs. 737.90 per qtls. of W/atta fixed by the Govt. and for distribution of same through Public distribution System at quantum per FIC as shown against their names.

It is further ordered that, the allottee G.P.S.S. Limited/W.C.C.S. shall deposit the ex-mill price of wholemeal atta as per procedure to the Roller Flour Mills concerned and also to obtain necessary endorsement of quantity of whole meal Atta to be lifted (wholly or partly) according to allotment, in the 'Permit Book' from Food, Civil Supplies and Consumer Affairs Branch, Kamrup. The Roller Flour Mills in turn shall release wholemeal atta (FAQ) forthwith and also make necessary records in the 'Permit Book' of the allottee GPSS/WCCS Limited showing the cash memo number with date and quantity issued etc. and distribution is to be completed by 20-9-2013 among the consumers.

The Adjustment of W/atta from APL Regular and Addl. APL quota have been required to make the quantum @ 5.500 kg per APL FIC as sub-allocated below.

5. All R.F. Mills of Kamrup Sadar Sub-Division for favour of information. They are requested to issue the allotted quantity of W/Atta under PDS as per sub-allocation made above to all GPSS/WCCS Limited on payment of value.
6. Addl. DC, i/c FCS & CA Kamrup and Chairman of the monitoring committee for information. The committee shall monitor the quality, lifting and distribution of the wheat products as per instructions issued vide order No. KSL 117/2012/24 dtd. 24/7/2013.

8. The Assistant Registrar of Co-Operative Societies, Guwahati for information.
