No.KSL.22/2010/182-187 (i) Pursuant to the Directorate of Food, Civil Supplies and Consumer Affairs, Assam, Guwahati's W.T. Message No. DS.1/2011/56 dated 10.04.2012 and in exercise of the powers conferred by clause-26 read with clause-28(b) of the Assam Public Distribution of Articles Order, 1982, I, Sri S. K. Roy, ACS, Deputy Commissioner, Kamrup, Amingaon do hereby make the Government Oil Companies Kerosene Agency (as the appointed sub-wholesale dealer wise) break up allocation of Kerosene Oil (blue dyed) for the month of **April/May/June'2012** in respect of Kamrup Sadar Sub-Division as detailed below for making ultimate distribution amongst the Family Identity Card holders/Special Permit Holders through respective appointed retailers at a price already fixed by the Licensing Authority in this regard.

The abovesaid allottee dealers shall ensure that percent filling of quantities of kerosene oil is made allotted from concerned contracts on payment of full billed price within 25th day of the month for which the allotment is made for. The kerosene oil bill as issued against regular monthly supply shall have to be issued to appointed retailers by 1st of the month in Urban and Rural Area of 4,250 litres. Per FIC per month, Hawkers of 150 litres per month and Retailers of 100 litres per month including the quantities issued against special permit etc. as per above stipulated price for equitable distribution amongst all concerned through appointed retailers/hawkers/Retailers at a price already fixed by the Deputy Commissioner, Kamrup vide his Memo No. KSI.43/65/66 A dated 13.07.2011 in exercise of the powers conferred by Clause (b) read with Clause 11 and Clause 18(b) of the Assam Public Distribution of Articles Order, 1983 and also Clause 4(a) of the Kerosene Restriction on Use and Distribution of Kerosene Order, 1993 (as amended).

Again, with a view to ensuring uninterrupted availability of the best kerosene oil for domestic use under PDS through out each month, the allottee Sub Wholesale dealers shall have to fill 60% of monthly allocation by 10th, 20% of monthly allocation by 17th and remaining 15% of monthly allocation by 25th of each of month of allocation positively. In the event of non-compliance to this office instructions contained in letter no KSI.71/00/13 dated 08.10.2010, all kerosene agencies are hereby directed to submit arrival report of each consignment of kerosene oil to respective Circle Officers/Block Development officers for physical verification of stock so arrived and to allow distribution of same amongst GPSS and their agents, hawkers and retailers by way of issuing a certificate to the Kerosene Agency concerned.

Any deviation from compliance to this order shall be dealt with under Section 7 of the Essential Commodities Act - 1955

8. P.S. to the Hon'ble Minister, Food, Civil Supplies & Consumers Affairs, Dispur, Guwahati for kind appraisal of the Minister.
9. All Inspectors/Sub-Inspectors, Food, Civil Supplies & Consumers Affairs, Kamrup for information & necessary action. They are directed to supervise the lifting & distribution of kerosene oil of their respective areas. They shall also ensure timely deposit of value of allotted quantity kerosene oil by the kerosene agencies for **ensuring cent percent lifting by 25th day each month** apart from conducting regular checking on distribution of kerosene oil made by the F.P.Shops dealers/Hawkers and Retailers as per Govt. instruction issued from time to time in this regard.
10. All Kerosene Agencies (i.e. sub-whole sellers) for information & necessary action. They shall ensure cent percent lifting of Blue-dyed kerosene oil by **25th day of each month as per schedule of lifting mentioned above and issue the same as per quantum fixed herein above to appointed retailers (F.P.Shop), hawkers and kerosene retailers attached to their respective depots well ahead before last day of the month of which the allotment is meant for. It is further directed that the depot holders concerned shall not released any quantity of kerosene oil to those hawkers/retailers who were found absent in course of recent verification of hawkers and retailers made in the month of April/2007, without receiving separate order for realizing kerosene oil to them from this office.**
11. The District Informatics Officer, NIC, Kamrup. He is requested to publish the allocation order on District website as per Government standing instructions.
12. The C.E.O., Zila Parishad, Kamrup, Guwahati.
13. All Block Development Officers under Kamrup Sadar Sub Division for information and necessary action.
